



## Gerry Johansson

Linkimage is proud to present photographer Gerry Johansson whom has just recently joined the agency. During this spring we will update our archives with a lot of his fantastic landscape and architecture images from the USA, Germany, Japan and many other places around the world. A unique collection with a very special feeling that is best described as Gerry Johansson.

During the month of April his work can be seen at a large exhibit at the Hasselblad center in Gothenburg, don't miss it if you happen to be in Sweden at this time. The book *Kvidinge/ Gerry Johansson*, (edited by Greger Ulf Nilson and Gerry Johansson and designed by Henrik Nygren) will be published in connection to this exhibition. The writer Johan Croneman describes Gerry Johanssons work in the catalog for the exhibition like this:

"It always seems as if someone, and just recently, have been standing in Gerrys images, but just walked out of there. No one has touched anything, or done anything, not made any trouble, not disturbed, not interrupted or moved anything. Just been there for a little while, walked in that very moment and walked out of the picture. It especially appears in his most quite and peaceful images, but also in pictures with other people, for example some of his work from America, seems to be missing someone that has just left them. And it becomes even more obvious after Gerry Johansson the photographer has left, taken his picture, packed

his things and found another object to focus on. I can't find anything, not the smallest little thing, in any of Gerrys images, that isn't exactly what it is or pretends to be something else. You wish you could be such a person. One who doesn't pretend or make things up."

The exhibition *I utkanten av sin tillvaro*, with photographs from 1978–2006, is open at Hasselblad Center in Gothenburg 21 April–3 June 2007.
