



Brendan Austin

We have extended our archive with yet another photographer in Link Image, Brendan Austin. Brendan was born in New Zealand in the mid 1970s and has moved around the world since he was a young child. He lived in London for several years where he took his degree in Photography at the London College of Printing. Brendan came to Sweden in 2003 and undertook photo assignments for a number of clients, including Acne Paper, Kone Cranes, Eurostar, NK and SAAB.

His photographs have been exhibited at the Photographers Gallery in London, Centrum för Fotografi and the Jonas Kleerup Gallery in Stockholm and at the Miami Art Fair.

He describes his work thus: "I have always been interested in exploring border landscapes. These have included the hidden tunnels under London, a remote radio telescope in Latvia and a nuclear submarine base in Ukraine. Recently I have been occupied by traveling to the deserts of Jordan in the Middle East. I am attracted to finding moments and landscapes that might be considered unusual and creating a dialog with them with my photography".

Brendan Austin divides his time between New York and Stockholm to enjoy the best of two worlds.
